- FLIP+ is an **international community** of leading educational institutions, committed to sharing assessment tools and best practices, **improving education worldwide**.
- FLIP+ founded a **consortium** in 2023, bringing together 5 of its national member institutions and the UNESCO Institute for Statistics (UIS) to build the FLIP+ Library.
  - The FLIP+ Library is an open-source, educational resource platform that strives to improve the quality of education worldwide, contributing to the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs).
  - The FLIP+ Library's pilot release will take place before the end of March 2025. The FLIP+ community release date will be announced at the 8th Annual FLIP+ Event (June 2025).

The association FLIP+, founded in 2019 by four national member institutions, is an international community of institutions committed to promoting the culture of educational assessment as an essential factor in improving the quality of education worldwide. As of January 2025, the association includes 25 national member institutions as well as the UNESCO Institute for Statistics (UIS).



Using the FLIP+ Library, policymakers, administrators, and educators can:




